CONTEXT- HEART

This is a very natural moment to make sure your students are clear on the Gospel. Paul shares what Christ comes to do for us in his Messianic poem, this can be followed as an outline if needed.

Give space for students to consider if they truly believe the Gospel and want it to shape their whole lives.

Be prepared to share on how the Gospel has shaped your life.

QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR STUDENTS - HEART

1. What is the Gospel? Do you believe it? How so?
2. Who is Jesus?
3. Are you ready and willing to let the Gospel shape your life? How so?
4. Is there anything about this that is scary to you? How so?
5. Is there any ways you can sense God the Holy Spirit calling you to go deeper in your faith? How so?
6. How do we build a community committed to living out the faith?
7. What are some things that come against our ability to do this?

APPLICATION - HANDS

Challenge students to go away and consider if there is a deeper commitment they need to embrace when it comes to following Jesus.
