Here is a way to keep God's Word in front of you every day during the 10 Chapters deal:

Sunday: Read the chapter.

Monday: Highlight or Underline one part of the chapter.

Tuesday: Pray through the chapter.

Wednesday: Express something from the chapter via art or social media.

Thursday: Read the chapter out loud with a friend.

Friday: Write about the chapter.

Saturday: Read the chapter again.

Important verse this week: The Word became flesh and made his

dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Here's a way to remember the John in verse 6...call him:

What is "His own" in verse 11?

Who can become children of God?

What happened to the Word in verse 14?

Notice the way John helps his readers understand everything. There is a progression from verse 1 to 9 to 14...and details between these verses and after them.

There are four different ways people came to Jesus just in this chapter:

- Andrew came to Jesus because of the preaching of John.
- \cdot Peter came to Jesus because of the witness of his brother.
- · Phillip came to Jesus as a result of the direct call of Jesus.
- Nathaniel came to Jesus as he overcame personal prejudices by a personal encounter with Jesus.

Look at the four different witnesses testifying to the identity of Jesus, just in this chapter:

- · John the Baptist testified that Jesus is eternal, that He is the man uniquely anointed with the Holy Spirit, that He is the Lamb of God, and that Jesus is the unique Son of God.
- · Andrew testified that Jesus is the Messiah, the Christ.
- Phillip testified that Jesus is the One prophesied in the Old Testament.
- Nathaniel testified that Jesus is the Son of God and the King of Israel.

Look at how John introduces Jesus, gives some of the most profound theological truths in an understandable way, and goes back and forth from who Jesus is to those who knew Jesus (like JTB, Andrew, Phillip, etc)
